ENTIRE BOTTLING PLANT MOVED FROM WESTMEAD TO BLOEMFONTEIN

The entire bottling plant of Continental Beverages - whose lease was due for expiry at the end of the year at its Westmead, Pinetown premises - was put onto 15 low bed trailers and transported to the company's self-owned premises in Bloemfontein.

It was decided to use the winter months for the project when the de-

mand for soft drinks is not as pressing as it is during peak season. Continental Beverages produces such concentrates as Wild Island and Dalys.

According to Piet van der Walt from Continental Beverages who worked closely with Lovemore Bros technical staff during the big move, the project was executed smoothly and efficiently and the plant is already operational in time for the summer months.

Jerry Munsamy, Operations Manager responsible for long distance hauls at

Lovemore, said the two week project was carried out without any problems. They were able to contain the cargo on the low bed trailers without having to resort to police escorts.

The bottling plant which was offloaded and positioned at its new home in the Free State included numerous tanks and tank support structures, fillers, case sealers, labelling equipment, compressors, conveyors and conveyor walkways.
